Nolan Catholic High School is a private, co-educational, and college preparatory school. Founded in 1961, Nolan Catholic serves approximately 1,100 students per year in grades 9-12 in the ministry of the Catholic Diocese of Fort Worth under the administration of the Society of Mary (Marianists). NCHS is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and the Texas Catholic Conference Education Department (as approved by the Texas Education Agency). Of the 105 professional faculty, eight are vowed Religious and 97 are lay faculty. More than 57% hold advanced degrees including 57 master's and three doctoral degrees.

The traditional college preparatory curriculum at Nolan Catholic requires 28 Carnegie units for graduation. Advanced Placement and Honors courses are offered in multiple disciplines. Students in AP and honors courses attaining a minimum 77 average or higher (0-100 grade scale, with passing 70 or greater) receive eight extra points. Approximately 98% of Nolan Catholic graduates attend college. Most recently, the class of 2007 reported scholarship offers totaling more than \$2.76 million. All students graduate with at least a Recommended Plan Diploma.
