

Consequences for Incomplete Hours

For each school year, there will be a final due date for hours to be counted toward that school year. The date will be published in the NCHS calendar and will be given as a reminder in the Spring Semester to students. If hours are not completed by this date (NOT the last day of school), the student will be placed on academic probation. The student will remain on probation until the required number of hours is completed. Being on academic probation will affect ability to participate in extracurricular activities as follows.

Since Christian Ministry Hours are a graduation requirement, deficiency in hours will be counted as one course failure. Once the student fulfills the hours requirement, the deficiency is remedied and the student's "failure" is considered corrected. Therefore, a student with two or more course failures or one course failure and deficiency in the Christian Ministry hour requirement will be ineligible for participation in extracurricular activities.
